

Special Education Procedures Concerning Busing

Dear Parent/Guardian,

We realize and understand that there are times when you might not be able to be home on time to meet your child's bus when it arrives in the afternoon. It is the Cleveland Metropolitan School District's policy not to release your child to any unknown adults or an empty house. This is for the safety of your child and the protection of the driver. Please be advised that if no one is home to receive your student, the bus drivers are instructed to take your student to Max Hayes High School. They will be kept at Max Hayes until 5:30pm then transferred to Jane Edna Hunter Social Services Center on Euclid Ave. You may retrieve your child before 5:30 at Max Hayes. After 5:30, the student will be at Jane Edna Hunter.

To avoid these types of problems, we are asking that you designate up to three adults (18 years or older) to meet the student in your absence. Please give this information to the driver by filling out this form. Also, you can get information by calling our afternoon dispatch number at 216-838-4287.
